Coronation of King Charles III

May 12, 2023: The coronation of Charles III and his wife, Camilla as the King and the Queen respectively of the United Kingdom took place on Saturday May 6, 2023, in Westminster Abbey, London. King Charles is the oldest British king ever to be crowned, at the age of 74. The King is the head of state of the United Kingdom, the Commonwealth Realms and the head of the Commonwealth (an association of 56 countries). However, his powers are only symbolic and ceremonial, and he remains politically neutral.

The coronation service was an Anglican service of the Holy Communion that took place in front of more than 2000 guests. The guests at the coronation included American pop star Katy Perry, British actress Emma Thompson, American singer Lionel Richie as well as British prime minister Rishi Sunak and wife Akshata Murty and Indian Vice President Jagdeep Dhankar. Indian actress Sonam Kapoor Ahuja welcomed the guests and attended the coronation concert at the Windsor Castle but did not attend the main coronation.

William, the Prince of Wales, aged 40 and his son Prince George, aged 9 are now the two heirs of the UK throne ascended by the monarch King Charles III. Later the King and the Queen expressed their thanks on the glorious occasion to the public.

Fun fact: Kings and queens have been coronated in Westminster Abbey for thousands of years. So now we have learnt about the coronation of the newest monarch of the United Kingdom. Long Live the King! 🙄

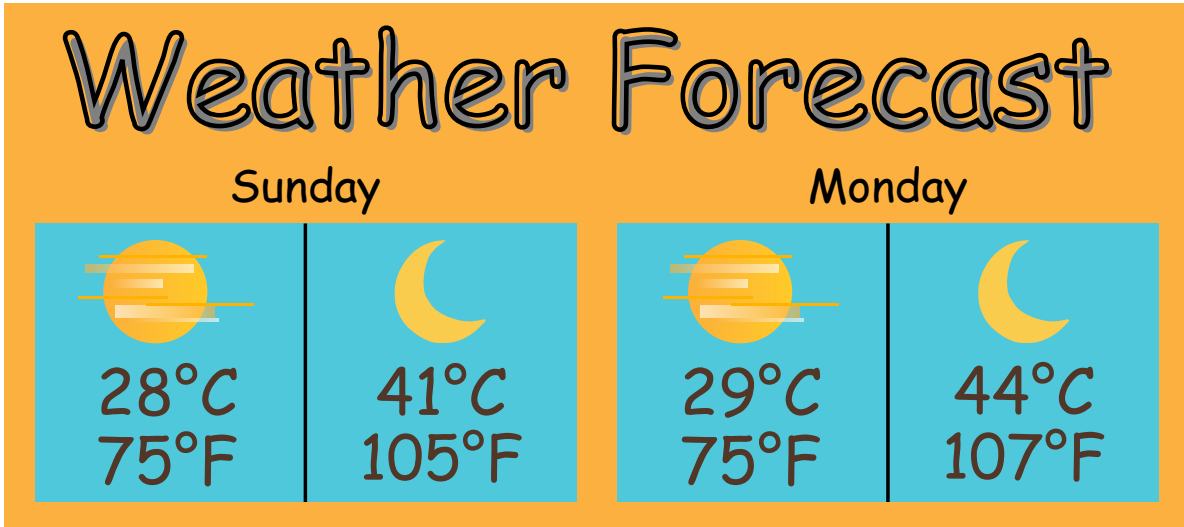

Canadian state of Alberta declares state of emergency due to wildfires.

May 12: Raging wildfires across the Canadian province of Alberta has caused damage to millions of acres in Canada. Because of unusually dry spring this year, more than 100 wildfires have driven nearly 30,000 residents out of their homes. The Alberta province government has declared a state of emergency as more than 25 of active wildfires are classified as "out of control". Satellite images show much of Canada is covered in smoke as of Thursday evening, reaching as far as Quebec and Ontario near U.S.A. As the fires in Alberta continue to cause mayhem, officials have shut down around 30 schools affecting around 6,000 students. Experts say long-lasting heat due to climate change plays a huge role in causing these increasing wildfires. #ACTNOW

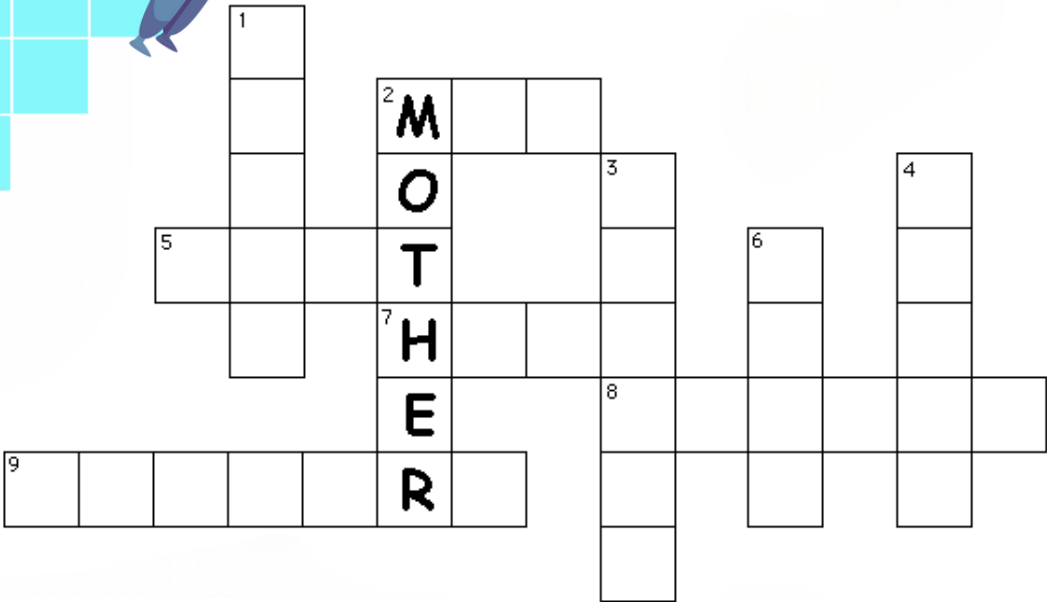


GHAZIABAD

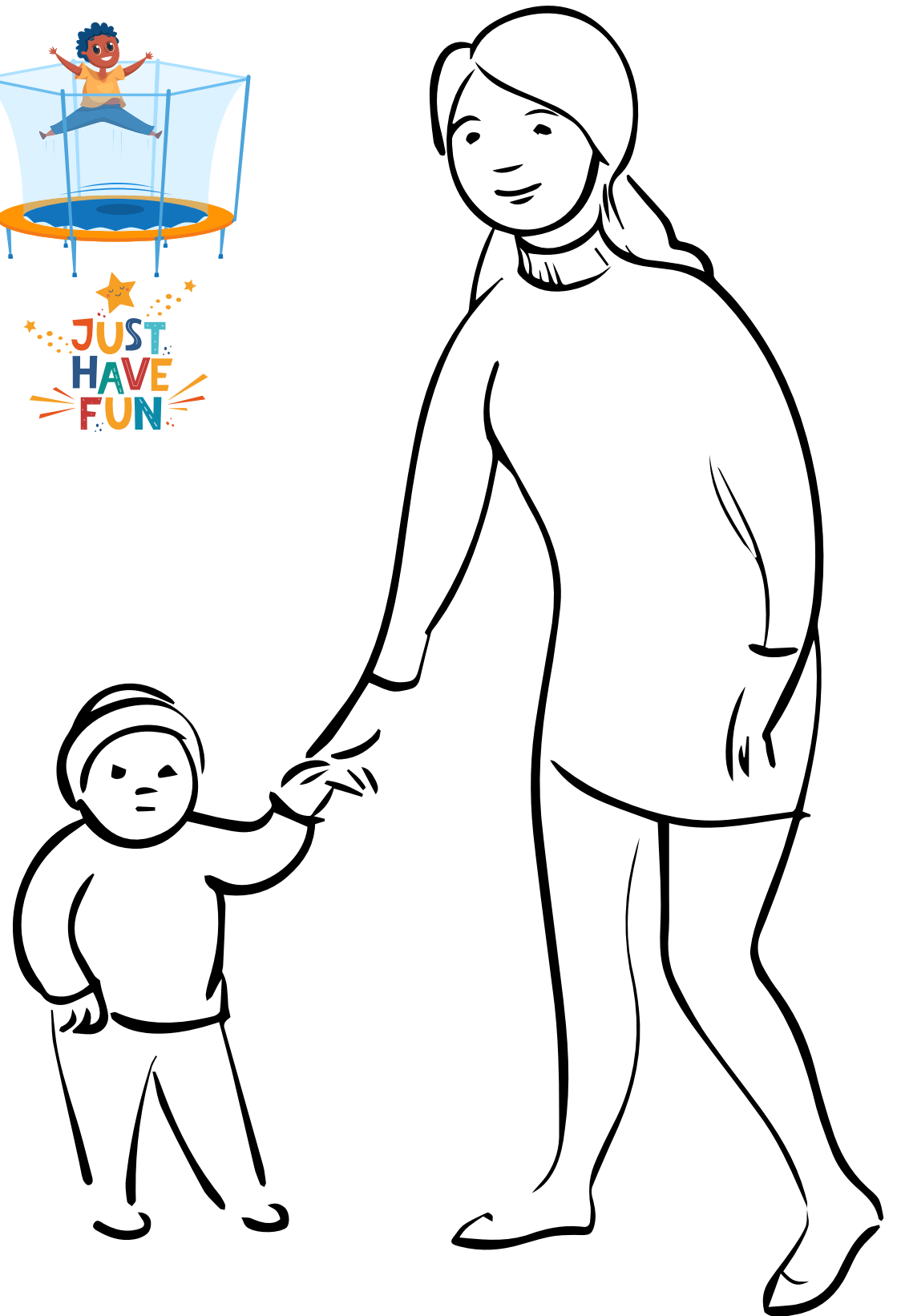

Olympic champion Neeraj Chopra won gold medal in men's javelin field at the Doha Diamond League last week. He bagged the impressive world-leading 88.67m throw, thus becoming the Trophy winner this year. He defeated last year's world champion Anderson Peters to win this first-of-the-top-tier track and field athletic event making Indians proud.

Meanwhile other Indian athletes, namely Praveen Chithravel, Avinash Sable and Parul Chaudhary also set national records in international events on the eve of World Athletics Day. Praveen set new national record in Triple Jump and qualified for the world Championships in Budapest. Parul broke the national record set by Preeja in women's 5000m in LA Track Festival clocking 15:10:35, while, Avinash from Indian Men's team broke his own national record in 5000m clocking 13:19:30.
